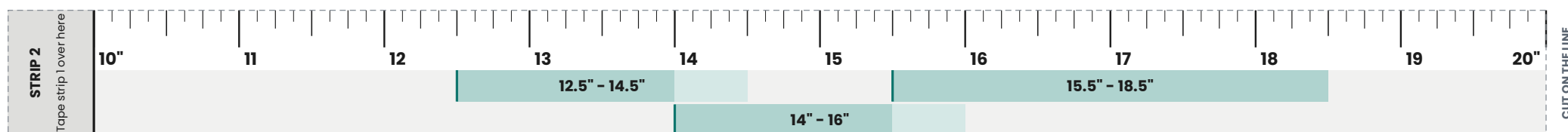
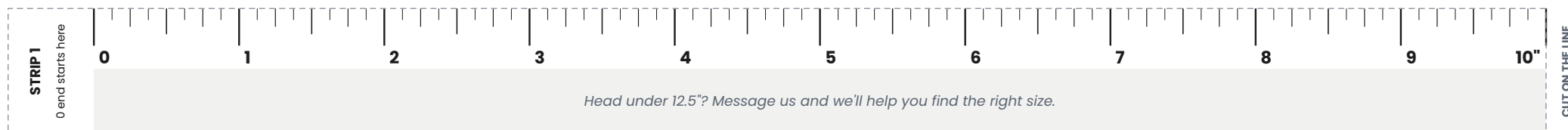


Greyhound and lurcher collar size tape

Wrap this tape around the narrowest part of your hound's head and the coloured bar shows you which collar size to choose.



 The size we'd recommend at that measurement

 Still within the size, though the next size up is the better fit

Getting it ready

- 1 Print at 100% or "Actual size", with "Fit to page" turned off.
- 2 Check a bank card fits the box on the right exactly. If the edges line up, your tape is the right scale.
- 3 Cut out both strips along the dashed lines.
- 4 Lay the end of strip 1 over the grey tab on strip 2, with its edge on the bold 10" line, and tape it in place.

Measuring your hound

- 1 Find the narrowest part of your greyhound or lurcher's head, just under the chin and behind the ears.
- 2 Wrap the tape around that spot so it's fairly snug against the fur
Don't put any fingers underneath the tape.
- 3 Find the number where the 0 end meets the tape. The coloured bar under that number is the size to choose.
- 4 Wiggly hound? A piece of string works well. Mark where it meets and lay it flat along the tape.

SCALE CHECK

Place a bank card here.
It should match this outline exactly.



This line is exactly 2"

Card a little off? Reprint at 100%.

Between two sizes?

If your hound falls between two sizes, for example a 14" head lands in both the 12.5" - 14.5" and the 14" - 16" collar, get in touch and we can make a collar that will fit perfectly.
